In view of difficulties, various problems & procedural delays experienced in fixing procurement prices of vegetable seeds timely, it was felt necessary to adopt uniform procedures and practices on different aspects of procurement price finalisation. For this purpose, comprehensive uniform guidelines and policy is framed. A set of the Policy for of Vegetable seed (Ann-1,1A&1B) and Fixation of sale price of BS/FS/C/S/TL/PS (Ann-2 & 2A) of all Vegetable seeds duly approved by NSC Board of Directors in 272 meeting held on 30-06-2017 is enclosed for information and compliance.

You are requested to circulate the same to the officers/offices working under your control. It may please be ensured that these approved Guidelines and Policy are followed mandatorily and complied with immediate effect.

## GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF VEGETABLE SEED PRODUCTION

SALE PRICE OF PARENTAL MATERIAL

The procurement price policy of the Corporation was approved in the 262<sup>nd</sup> meeting of the Board held on 17/28.8.15. In the policy the sale price of the planting material was decided as under:-

Point No. 10

"Sale price of planting material to NSC seed growers will be circulated equivalent to subsidized sale(GSP)+ Rs. 25/- per qtl, for CS -I. Rs. 100/- per qtl, for FS and Rs. 250/- per qtls. for BS."

Point No. 11

"Sale price of planting material to organizers or private seed companies shall be none subsidized sale price of CS + 5% of CS-I and I0% for FS."

The Govt, of India has recently increased the subsidy for distribution under NMOOP from Rs. 1200/- to Rs. 2500/- and therefore, fixation of sale price of planting material on this basis is likely to have major financial implication on Corporation for which the present pricing policy needs to be reviewed taking into consideration of total cost incurred on production of planting material.

It is, therefore, proposed that the procurement price policy may be revised based on cosung as:

Point No. 10 (R)

"Total direct cost + over heads + Rs. 25/- per qtl. for CS -I. Rs. 100/- per qtl. for FS and Rs. 250/- per qtls. for BS.."

Point No. 11 (R)

"Total direct cost + over heads + 5% of CS-I and 10% for FS."

In case at any stage the cost of planting material is found high by RM, the Committee of SGM(P), SGM(M)/Directors with the approval of CMD may revise the sale price of planting material on the recommendation of RM.

Accordingly the Board may please pass the following resolution:-

"Resolved that the revision in fixation of sale price of planting material is hereby approved as per point no .10 (R) and point No 11 (R) duly repealing the existing policy stated at point No 10 and point No 11.

#### B- CHANGES IN POLOCY PERIOD

Time and again Regional Managers are requesting for the changes in the Crop-wise APMC Price Period for deciding Procurement rate due to several reasons like delayed sowing; early maturity of the crop due to climatic imbalances/ inclement weather besides sudden situational price hike of a particular commodity. For every such revision approaching to the Board is difficult. For such quick seasonal decisions for the changes in the policy period may be approved by the CMD.

Accordingly the Board may please pass the following resolution:-

"Resolved that the execution of powers by CMD for the revision in Crop-wise APMC Price Period for deciding Procurement rate is approved."
